

# LABOUR'S 100% LIES ABOUT 10% CUTS

## From the mouth of Gordon Brown:

1. "The Conservatives are now ideologically committed to **10 per cent. cuts** in public services. That is not the policy of this Government. We are the party of growth; we are the party of jobs." (Hansard, 29 June 2009)
2. "I have always told the truth and I've always told people as it is... we don't want to have the **10 per cent cuts** the Conservatives are talking about" (*Evening Standard*, 2 July 2009).
3. "Let us remember the alternative—a Conservative party that wants to cut spending now, cut spending next year and then **cut most major spending Departments by 10 per cent.**" (Hansard, 29 July 2009)
4. "His is the party of **10 per cent. cuts** in public expenditure, and the party that would cut the vital public services at a time of recession." (Hansard, 24 June 2009)
5. "Why does he not admit that there would be **10 per cent. cuts** in public services under the Conservatives?" (Hansard, 24 June 2009)
6. "What the right hon. Gentleman is saying to us—he had better listen to the debate because it will go on for many months—is that, regardless of growth, employment, interest rates or inflation, he is dogmatically set on a **10 per cent. cut** in most departmental expenditures." 7. "The first thing we are absolutely sure of is that, regardless of economic circumstances, employment, investment and inflation, the Conservatives will **cut expenditure by 10 per cent.**" (Hansard, 17 June 2009)
8. "Once again, he is trying to hide the fact that he has got **10 per cent. cuts**. His is the party of cuts; we are the party of investment." (Hansard, 17 June 2009)
9. "Let him come clean: he would cut public expenditure this year, next year and every year after. He is trying to evade his responsibility for wanting **10 per cent. cuts.**" (Hansard, 24 June 2009)
10. "We have brought forward public expenditure to help people stay in their homes and get into jobs and to help build schools and hospitals. Those are exactly the public services that the Conservatives would cut savagely, by **10 per cent.** That is not going to be allowed to happen." (Hansard, 24 June 2009)
